Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

REGENT STREET (DOUGLAS)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Regent Street (Douglas) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic Order) 1990 and shall come into operation on the 19th February 1990.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that length of Regent Street at its junction with Loch Promenade.

Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the works to be carried out.

Suspension of One-Way Traffic

4. The provisions of the One-Way Traffic Streets Order, 1981 shall cease to have effect in respect of Drumgold Street during the period that this Order is in force.

Duration

5. This Order shall continue in force until 19th March 1990 or until the sewer repair work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to close to vehicular traffic the junction of Regent Street, Douglas with Loch Promenade during the period that sewer repairs are being undertaken. The One-Way traffic system over Drumgold Street is suspended for the period that the temporary closure operates.
