

THE SUPERANNUATION ACT 1984

THE AIRPORT FIREMEN'S SUPERANNUATION SCHEME 1989

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Civil Service Commission by sections 1(1) and 12(1) of the Superannuation Act 1984(a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Scheme is hereby made -

Citation and commencement

1. This Scheme may be cited as the Airport Firemen's Superannuation Scheme 1989 and, subject to section 12(1) of the Act, shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st January 1990.

Interpretation

2. (1) In this Scheme -

"the Act" means the Superannuation Act 1984;

"the Department" means the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties;

"the Firemen's Scheme" means the Isle of Man Firemen's Pension Scheme 1980(b);

"the Commission" means the Civil Service Commission.

(2) In this Scheme "airport fireman" means a person -

(a) who is employed by the Department for the purpose of fire-fighting at an airport maintained by the Department; or

(b) who is a member of the Isle of Man Civil Service, whose duties wholly or mainly relate to fire-fighting at such an airport,

and (except in the case of a person employed full-time as in (a) above) in respect of whom the Commission has by an instrument in writing directed that this Scheme shall apply to him.

Application of Firemen's Scheme to airport firemen

3. (1) For the purpose of providing superannuation for airport firemen, the Firemen's Scheme shall apply to the Island subject to sub-paragraph (2) and to the following modifications -

for references to members of the fire brigades substitute references to airport firemen;

for the reference to the Lieutenant Governor substitute a reference to the Commission; and

(2) In its application to airport firemen, paragraph 96(1) (retiring age) of the scheme set out in Appendix 2 to the Firemen's Pension Scheme Order 1973(c), as it applies to firemen by virtue of the Firemen's Scheme, shall have effect subject to the following modifications -


- (a) the words from "(a)" to "any lower rank," are omitted;
- (b) in the case of a person mentioned in paragraph 2(2)(b), the functions of the fire authority are exercisable by the Commission.

Transitional provision for existing airport firemen


4. This scheme does not apply to an airport fireman who is an airport fireman on the coming into operation of this Scheme -

- (a) in the case of a person mentioned in paragraph 2(2)(a), unless and until a registered medical practitioner appointed by the Commission has certified that he complies with the medical standards prescribed by the Civil Aviation Authority for personnel employed for rescue and firefighting duties at aerodromes;
- (b) in the case of a person mentioned in paragraph 2(2)(b), unless and until he has agreed in writing that this Scheme shall apply to him.
