Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

MURRAY'S ROAD LANE (DOUGLAS)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Murray's Road Lane (Douglas) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1990, and shall come into operation on the 1st March, 1990.

Closure of Lane to Traffic

2. No vehicular or pedestrian traffic shall proceed in that length of the lane at the rear of the properties numbered 38 to 52 Murray's Road in the Borough of Douglas.

Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles or pedestrians engaged in the sewer works being undertaken.

Duration

4. This Order shall continue in operation until the 31st March, 1990, or until the work is completed, whichever is the earlier.
