BRADDAN BRIDGE/MOUNT RULE ROAD  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Braddan Bridge/Mount Rule Road (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1990 and shall come into operation on 10th March 1990.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that section of the Braddan Bridge to Mount Rule Road from its junction with the Ballafletcher Road northwards to a point opposite to Leece Lodge Farm Buildings.

Exemption

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the works to be carried out.

Duration

4. This Order shall be in force on the 10th and 11th March 1990 between the hours of 9.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. or until the tree limbing work is terminated on both of these dates.
