PORT ST MARY FILM ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 38 of the Highways Act 1986 (a) and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Port St Mary Film Order 1990 and shall come into operation on the 18th March, 1990.

Interpretation

2. In this Order:-

"the Department" means the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties;

"the film area" means the road set out and described in the Schedule;

"promoters" means London Weekend Television;

"film days" means the days specified in Article 4;

"film periods" means the periods of time specified in Article 4 when the film area (subject to Article 3) is closed to traffic.

Closure of Roads to Traffic

3. During the film periods on the film days, the film area shall be closed to and the right of traffic to proceed thereover suspended for all traffic other than such traffic as may be authorised by the promoters and the Chief Constable.

Film Periods

4. The film area may be used during the film periods for filming on:-

(a) Sunday, 18th March, 1990 from 8.00 a.m. until 9.00 p.m.

(b) Monday, 19th March, 1990 from 6.00 p.m. until 8.00 p.m.

or such time at which the filming ends, whichever is the earlier.

Erection of Barriers

5. During the filming periods the promoters may cause barriers to be erected or maintained at or near to the junction of the scheduled road with those roads leading into the scheduled road. Such barriers must be dismantled and removed immediately after the conclusion of the film period.

Duty of Police to Notify Completion of Film Periods

6. It shall be the duty of the senior police officer present to make such provision as seems most expedient for giving official notification to the public of the conclusion of a film period and of the opening of the scheduled road to traffic.

Notice of Making of Order

7. Public notice of this Order shall be given by advertisement in two Isle of Man Newspapers.
