Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

LAKE LANE (PEEL)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Lake Lane (Peel) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1990 and shall come into operation on the 20th March 1990.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that length of Lake Lane (Peel) abutting the gable wall of the Creek Inn.

Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the works to be carried out.

Duration

4. This Order shall continue in force during the 20th March 1990 or until the gas service work is completed whichever is the earlier.
