Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

HOPE STREET (CASTLETOWN)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Hope Street (Castletown) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1990 and shall come into operation on 20th March 1990.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that length of Hope Street, Castletown in the immediate vicinity of the property situated thereon and numbered 13.

Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the works to be carried out.

Duration

4. This Order shall continue in force until the 23rd March 1990 or until the surface water drainage connection work is completed, whichever is the earlier.
