Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

MOUNT HAVELOCK (DOUGLAS)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Mount Havelock (Douglas) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1990 and shall come into operation on the 24th March 1990.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that length of Mount Havelock in the Borough of Douglas situated between Albert Street and Mona Street.

Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the works to be carried out.

Duration

4. This Order shall continue in force until the 25th March, 1990 or until the crane dismantling work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to close to vehicular traffic, the length of Mount Havelock, Douglas situated between Albert Street and Mona Street over the 2 days that crane dismantling works are being undertaken.
