The Social Fund Maternity and Funeral Expenses (General)

The Social Fund Maternity and Funeral Expenses (General) (Isle of Man) (Amendment) Regulations 1990 made on 1st March 1990 by the Department of Health and Social Security in exercise of the powers contained in sections 32(2)(a) and 845(1) of the Social Security Act 1986 (an Act of Parliament) as it has effect in the Isle of Man.

In exercise of the powers contained in sections 32(2)(a) and 84(1) of the Social Security Act 1986 (an Act of Parliament) as it has effect in the Isle of Man (a) ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, the Department of Health and Social Security hereby makes the following regulations:-

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Fund Maternity and Funeral Expenses (General) (Isle of Man) (Amendment) Regulations 1989 and shall, subject to section 83(4) of the Act, come into force on 9th April 1990.
- (2) In these regulations "the principal regulations" means the Social Fund Maternity and Funeral Expenses (General) (Isle of Man) Regulations 1987 (b).

Amendment of Regulation 4 of the Principal Regulations

2. In regulation 4(2) of the principal regulations (amount of maternity payment) for "10th April 1989", "£85" and "£80" wherever occurring there shall be substituted "9th April 1990", "£100" and "£85" respectively.

Explanatory Note

These regulations which come into force on 9th April 1990 amend the Social Fund Maternity and Funeral Expenses (General) (Isle of Man) Regulations 1987 so as to prescribe £100 instead of £85 as the rate of a maternity payment.
