Public Service Vehicles (Inspection) Act 1928

HACKNEY MOTOR VEHICLES (INSPECTION AND CONDITION OF FITNESS)
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 3 of the Public Service Vehicles (Inspection) Act 1928 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following regulations are hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Hackney Motor Vehicles (Inspection and Condition of Fitness) (Amendment) Regulations 1990 and, subject to section 3 (2) of the Public Service Vehicles (Inspection) Act 1928, shall come into operation on the 1st April 1990.

Fee payable for a Certificate

2. The Hackney Motor Vehicles (Inspection and Condition of Fitness) Regulations 1970 shall be further amended by the substitution in regulation 6 of "£12.00" for "£10.00".

Revocation

3. The Hackney Motor Vehicles (Inspection and Condition of Fitness) (Amendment) Regulations 1987 are hereby revoked.
