Public Service Vehicles (Inspection) Act 1928

HACKNEY HORSE-DRAWN VEHICLES (INSPECTION) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 3 of the Public Service Vehicles (Inspection) Act 1928 (a) and of all other enabling powers, the following Regulations are hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Hackney Horse-Drawn Vehicles (Inspection) (Amendment) Regulations 1990 and, subject to section 3 (2) of the Public Service Vehicles (Inspection) Act 1928, shall come into operation on the 1st April, 1990.

Fee for a Certificate

2. The Hackney Horse-Drawn Vehicles (Inspection) Regulations 1979 (b) shall be further amended by the substitution in regulation 4 of "£7.00" for "£4.00".

Revocations

3. The Hackney Horse-Drawn Vehicles (Inspection) (Amendment) Regulations 1987 (c) are hereby revoked.
