THE MOTOR VEHICLES (DRIVING LICENCES) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by paragraph 22 (2) of Schedule 3 to the Road Traffic Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Regulations are hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) (Amendment) Regulations 1990 and, subject to section 74 (3) of the Road Traffic Act 1985, shall come into operation on the 1st April 1990.

Driving Test Fees

2. The Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) Regulations 1979 (b) shall be further amended in accordance with the following provisions of these Regulations:-

In regulation 16 (3) (Fees in respect of Tests) for paragraph 3 (b) there shall be substituted the following sub-paragraphs -

- " (b) in the case of a test to be taken on a vehicle of a class or description in Group I as specified in Schedule 5 shall be £20.00; and
- (c) in the case of a test to be taken on any other vehicle, shall be £16.00, save that no fee is payable in respect of a test to be taken in an invalid carriage. "

Explanatory Note
(This note is not a part of the Regulations)

The effect of these Regulations is twofold. The fee payable for the driving test for a heavy motor car (H.G.V.) is increased from £13 to £20; that for all other motor vehicles (other than an invalid carriage, a mowing machine or vehicle controlled by a pedestrian) is increased from £13 to £16.
