Licensing and Registration of Vehicles Act 1985

DESIGNATED VEHICLES (LICENCES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 13 (1) of the Licensing and Registration of Vehicles Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Regulations are hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Designated Vehicles (Licences) (Amendment) Regulations 1990 and subject to section 18 (3) of the Licensing and Registration of Vehicles Act 1985, shall come into operation on the 1st April 1990.

Application for Examinations and Fees Payable therefor

2. The Designated Vehicles (Licences) Regulations 1969 shall be further amended by substituting:-
 - (a) in regulation 6 (3) (a) "£7.00" for "£5.00"; and
 - (b) in regulation 6 (3) (b) "£15.00" for "£12.00".

Revocation

3. The Designated Vehicles (Licences) (Amendment) Regulations 1987 (b) are hereby revoked.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Designated Vehicles (Licences) Regulations 1969. These amendments increase the fee for the examination of a motor bicycle (without sidecar) from £5.00 to £7.00; that for other motor vehicles to which the 1969 Regulations apply from £12.00 to £15.00.
