Road Traffic (Public Service Vehicles) Act 1964

THE PUBLIC SERVICE VEHICLES (LICENCES AND CERTIFICATES)
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by sections 29 and 30 of the Road Traffic (Public Service Vehicles) Act 1964 (a) and of all other enabling powers, the following Regulations are hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Service Vehicles (Licences and Certificates) (Amendment) Regulations 1990 and, subject to section 30 (2) of the Road Traffic (Public Service Vehicles) Act 1964, shall come into operation on the 1st April 1990.

Fees

2. The Public Service Vehicles (Licences and Certificates) Regulations 1965 shall be further amended by the substitution in regulation 23 of "£30.00" for "£25.00".

Revocation

3. The Public Service Vehicles (Licences and Certificates) (Amendment) Regulations 1987 (b) are hereby revoked.

Explanatory Note

The effect of these Regulations is to increase from £25.00 to £30.00 the fee payable for the examination of a public service vehicle for the purposes of a certificate of fitness.
