HIGHWAYS ACT 1986

THE HIGHWAY DIVERSION (PORT ST MARY) (NO. 1) ORDER 1990

Whereas the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties is satisfied that it is expedient that the highway to which this Order relates should be diverted for the purpose of securing the efficient use of land adjoining the highway.

In exercise of the powers conferred on the said Department by section 33 (2) of the Highways Act 1986 (a) the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Highway Diversion (Port St Mary) (No. 1) Order 1990.
- (2) In this Order "the order map" means the map annexed to this Order and marked "Map referred to in the Highway Diversion (Port St Mary) (No. 1) Order 1990".

Diversion of Public Right of Way No. 311

2. On the date on which this Order takes effect:-
 - (a) the highway specified in Part I of the Schedule shall be extinguished; and
 - (b) a footpath shall be created over the land described in Part II of the Schedule.

S C H E D U L E

PART I

HIGHWAY EXTINGUISHED BY THIS ORDER

A length of footpath designated as Public Right of Way No. 311 on the definitive maps and statement at Fistard in the Village District of Port St Mary more particularly shown by a dotted line on the order map and running from a point to the rear of the property "Siroco" marked "A" on the order map for approximately 30 metres in a generally southerly direction to a point marked "B" on the order map.

PART II

HIGHWAY CREATED BY THIS ORDER

A footpath more particularly shown by a broken line on the order map and running from the said point marked "A" on the order map for approximately 25 metres in a generally southerly direction to the said point marked "B" on the order map.

Explanatory Note

This note is not a part of the Order

This Order diverts part of Public Right of Way No. 311 at Fistard in the Village District of Port St Mary.

Subject to the approval of Tynwald, the Order comes into effect on the publication of notice of making of the Order in accordance with Schedule 3 to the Highways Act 1986.

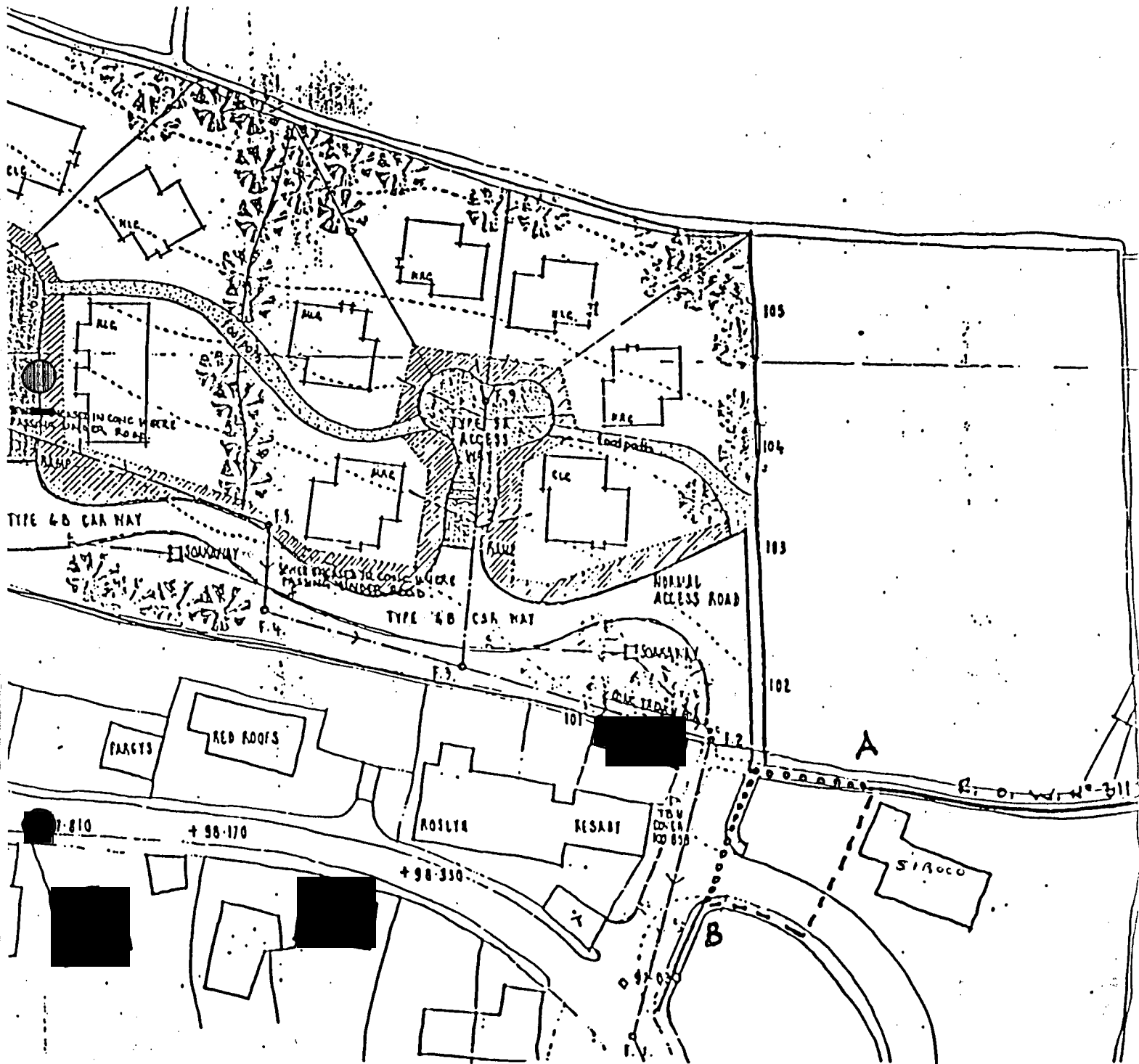
