Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

ALBERT TERRACE (DOUGLAS)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Albert Terrace (Douglas) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1990 and shall come into operation on the 1st April 1990.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that length of Albert Terrace in the Borough of Douglas fronting the former property situated thereon and known as Albert Terrace Residential Home.

Duration

3. This Order shall continue in force until the 4th April 1990, or until crane dismantling work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

The effect of this Order is to close to vehicular traffic that length of Albert Terrace, Douglas, fronting the former property situated thereon and called Albert Terrace Residential Home for a period that crane dismantling work is being undertaken.
