Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

FACTORY LANE (PEEL)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Factory Lane (Peel) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1990 and shall come into operation on the 2nd April 1990.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that length of Factory Lane in the town of Peel fronting the property situated thereon and numbered 11 during the hours of 9.00 a.m. until 4.00 p.m. each day.

Duration

3. This Order shall continue in force during the 6th April 1990 or until the replastering work is completed whichever is the earlier.

Suspension of One-Way Traffic

4. The provisions of paragraph (2) (k) of the Road Traffic Regulations made by the Peel Town Commissioners shall cease to have effect during the period this Order is in force.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to close to vehicular traffic that length of Factory Lane, Peel fronting the property situated thereon and numbered 11 for a period that replastering work is being undertaken. The one-way traffic system over Factory Lane is suspended for the duration of the Order.
