Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

UPPER DUKES ROAD/VICTORIA AVENUE (DOUGLAS)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Upper Dukes Road/Victoria Avenue (Douglas) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1990, and shall come into operation on the 10th April, 1990.

Restriction on Vehicles Waiting

2. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule.
