MARINE DRIVE RUNNING RACE ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 38 of the Highways Act 1986 (a) and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Marine Drive Running Race Order 1990, and shall come into operation on the 15th April 1990.

Interpretation

2. In this Order:-

"the Department" means the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties;

"the Course" means the roads and portions of roads set out and described in the Schedule and includes parts of the Course;

"marshal" means a marshal appointed by the Chief Constable under section 3 of the Road Races Act 1982 (b);

"promoters" means the Manx Athletic Club;

"race day" means the day specified in Article 3;

"race period" means the hour of 9.30 a.m. until the hour of 12.30 p.m.

Closure of Course to Traffic and Suspension of Right of Way

3. On the 15th April 1990, during the race period the course shall, subject to sub-paragraphs (a) to (e) be closed to, and the right of way thereover suspended for, all traffic other than:-

- (a) such traffic as may be authorised by promoters;
- (b) constables, special constables and marshals and vehicles approved for their conveyance by the Chief Constable;
- (c) persons appointed as officials for the races and vehicles approved for the conveyance by the promoters;
- (d) competitors engaged in the running races; and

(b) 1982 c.14

- (e) such other persons and vehicles as the Department or Chief Constable may authorise in writing.

Use of Course for Running Races

4. The Course may be used for running races on the race day and during the race periods.

Notice of the Making of the Order

5. Public notice of this Order shall be given by advertisement in two Isle of Man newspapers.
