

THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1985

THE LOCAL AUTHORITY MEMBERS (ATTENDANCE ALLOWANCES) ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Local Government and the Environment by paragraph 4 of Schedule 2 to the Local Government Act 1985 (a) and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Local Authority Members (Attendance Allowance) Order 1990.

(2) Subject to paragraph 4 (2) of Schedule 2 to the Act, this Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st April 1989.

(3) In this Order "the Act" means the Local Government Act 1985.

Attendance allowances

2. (1) The amount of an attendance allowance payable under paragraph 2 (1) of Schedule 2 to the Act shall be £13.04.

(2) The maximum allowances payable by virtue of paragraph 2 (3) of Schedule 2 to the Act shall be £978.00.

Revocation

3. The Local Authority Members (Attendance Allowances) Order 1988 (b) is revoked.

This Order prescribes the amount per session of attendance allowances payable to members of local authorities, and the maximum amount of allowances payable to a member in any one year. Retrospective effect is authorised by Schedule 2, paragraph 4, of the Local Government Act 1985.

The allowances will be payable only to those authorities who specifically resolve that such allowances have effect in their case.
