THE EDUCATION (COMMITTEES)(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 1990

These Regulations, a copy of which are attached, were made by the Governor in Council on 2nd March, 1990, were approved by Tynwald on 20th March, 1990, and came into operation on the 1st April, 1990.

The Education (Committees) Regulations 1987 established 6 Committees of the Isle of Man Department of Education; to each committee certain functions are allotted by the Education (Functions) Order 1987.

- (a) Regulation 3 (1) of the Regulations refers to the establishment of 'A Children Committee'
- (b) Schedule 1, paragraph 6 concerns the constitution of the Children Committee.

These Regulations have the effect of revoking reference to a Children Committee under existing regulations, thereby abolishing that Committee on the date of transfer of function.

THE EDUCATION (COMMITTEES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by paragraph 4 of Schedule 1 to the Education Act 1986(a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Regulations are hereby made:-

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Education (Committees) (Amendment) Regulations 1990 and, subject to section 4 of the Education Act 1986, shall come into operation on the 1st April 1990.


Amendment of principal Regulations

2. The following provisions of the Education (Committees) Regulations 1987(b) are revoked -

in regulation 3(1), the words "a Children Committee";

in Schedule 1, paragraph 6.
