THE TRANSFER OF FUNCTIONS (EMPLOYMENT) ORDER 1990

This Order, a copy of which is attached, was made by the Governor in Council on 2nd March, 1990, was approved by Tynwald on 20th March, 1990, and came into operation on the 1st April, 1990.

This Order transfers from the Department of Health and Social Security to the Department of Industry responsibility for employment functions included in the following statutes :-

- (a) The Employment Agencies Act 1975
- (b) The Control of Employment Act 1975
- (c) The Employers' Liability (Compulsory Insurance) Act 1976
- (d) The Contracts of Employment Act 1981
- (e) The Trade Disputes Act 1985
- (f) The Employment Act 1986

THE TRANSFER OF FUNCTIONS (EMPLOYMENT) ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by paragraphs 1, 3 and 4 of Schedule 2 to the Government Departments Act 1987(a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Transfer of Functions (Employment) Order 1990 and, subject to paragraph 4(4) of Schedule 2 to the Government Departments Act 1987, shall come into operation on the 1st April 1990.

Transfer of employment functions

2. The functions of the Department of Health and Social Security under the enactments specified in Schedule 1 are transferred to the Department of Industry.

Consequential amendments etc.

3. (1) The enactments specified in Schedule 2 are amended in accordance with that Schedule.

(2) The enactments specified in Schedule 3 are repealed to the extent specified in column 3 of that Schedule.

5. In section 8, for "Board" substitute "Department of Industry".


The Employment Act 1986

6. (1) In section 2(7), for "Health and Social Security (in this Act referred to as "the Department")" substitute "Industry".
- (2) In section 7(6), after the definition of "award" insert -
 ""the Department" means the Department of Health and Social Security;"
- (3) In section 10(1), after "Department" insert "of Industry".
