Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

GANSEY PROMENADE (RUSHEN) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC)
(REVOCATION) ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Gansey Promenade (Rushen) (One-Way Traffic) (Revocation) Order 1990, and shall come into operation on the 9th April, 1990.

Revocation of Principal Order

2. The Gansey Promenade (Rushen) (One-Way Traffic) Order 1989 (b) is hereby revoked.
