MERCHANT SHIPPING (OIL POLLUTION) ACT 1971.

MERCHANT SHIPPING (OIL POLLUTION) (APPLICATION) ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways Ports and Properties by sections 10(9) and 11(3) of the Merchant Shipping (Oil Pollution) Act 1971 (a) (an Act of Parliament) as extended to the Isle of Man by the Merchant Shipping (Oil Pollution) Act 1971 (Isle of Man) Order 1981 (b), and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and with the concurrence of the Treasury, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Oil Pollution) (Application) Order 1990 and, subject to sections 10(9) and 11(6) of the Merchant Shipping (Oil Pollution) Act 1971 (an Act of Parliament) as it has effect in the Isle of Man, shall come into operation on the 21st May 1990.

Application of subordinate legislation to the Isle of Man

2. The provisions of the Oil Pollution (Compulsory Insurance) (Amendment) Regulations 1990 (c) shall apply to the Isle of Man subject to the modifications and adaptations specified in the schedule to the Order

Revocation

3. The Merchant Shipping (Oil Pollution) (Application) Order 1982 (d) is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE

MODIFICATIONS AND EXCEPTIONS SUBJECT TO WHICH THE OIL POLLUTION (COMPULSORY INSURANCE) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 1990 (S.I. 1990 No 425) SHALL HAVE EFFECT IN THE ISLE OF MAN AND IN RELATION TO SHIPS REGISTERED IN THE ISLE OF MAN.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order is made by the Department of Highways Ports & Properties in exercise of its powers under sections 10 (9) and 11 (3) of the Merchant Shipping (Oil Pollution) Act 1971 (an Act of Parliament) as extended to the Isle of Man by the Merchant Shipping (Oil Pollution) (Isle of Man) Order 1981 and applies to the Isle of Man the Oil Pollution (Compulsory Insurance) (Amendment) Regulations 1990 which prescribe an increased fee of £25 to be paid on application for a certificate of compulsory insurance issued by the Department under section II of the 1971 Act.
