THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT (SPECIAL DRAINAGE DISTRICTS) ACTS
1952 AND 1959

THE SPECIAL DRAINAGE DISTRICTS (CONNECTING FEES) ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 6(3) of the Local Government (Special Drainage Districts) Act 1952(a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made: -

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Special Drainage Districts (Connecting Fees) Order 1990 and, subject to section 6 (3) of the Act, shall come into operation on the 1st June 1990.

(2) . In this Order "the Act" means the Local Government (Special Drainage Districts) Act 1952.

Connecting fees

2. The fees specified in the Schedule are prescribed for the purposes of section 6(3) (connecting fees) of the Act.

Revocation

3. The Special Drainage Districts (Connecting Fees) Order 1985(b) is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE

CONNECTING FEES

<i>Circumstances of connection</i>	<i>Fee</i>
1. Where the building served by the sewer or drain in question was in existence on or before the 19th August 1952:	
(a) where the premises are not divided into parts which are or are designed or adapted to be in separate occupation.	£50
(b) where the premises are divided into parts which are or are designed or adapted to be in separate occupation (except where (c) below applies	£50 plus £100 for each part in separate occupation
(c) where the premises are already connected to the public sewer and a further connection is made on forming a part designed or adapted to be in separate occupation	£50 for each additional part in separate occupation.
2. Where the building served by the sewer or drain in question was erected after the 19th August 1952:	
(a) where the premises are not divided into parts which are or are designed or adapted to be in separate occupation	£500
(b) where the premises are divided into parts which are or are designed or adapted to be in separate occupation (except where (c) below applies	£500 plus £100 for each part in separate occupation
(c) where the premises are already connected to the public sewer and a further connection is made on forming a part designed or adapted to be in separate occupation	£50 for each additional part in separate occupation

This Order increases the connecting fees payable on the connection of a building to a public sewer in a special drainage district (where the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties is responsible for sewerage.)
