THE HIGHWAY CLOSURE (DOUGLAS) (NO.1) ORDER 1990

Whereas the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties is satisfied that it is expedient that the highway to which this Order relates should be extinguished for the purposes of enabling development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission.

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department by section 33 (1) of the Highways Act 1986 (a), the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Interpretation

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Highway Closure (Douglas) (No.1) Order 1990.
- (2) In this Order "the order map" means the map annexed to this Order and marked "Map referred to in the Highway Closure (Douglas) (No.1) Order 1990".

Closure of Highways

2. On the date on which this Order takes effect the highway specified in the Schedule shall be extinguished.

Expenses

3. The following expenses, namely -
  - (a) any compensation which may become payable in consequence of the coming into operation of this Order;
  - (b) any expenses which may be incurred by the Department in making this Order and in complying with any requirement of I of Schedule 3 to the Highways Act 1986 in relation to this Order; and
  - (c) any expenses which may be incurred by the Department under Part II of the said Schedule 3 in consequence of the Order,as certified by or on behalf of the Treasury, shall be defrayed by the Corporation of Douglas.

## SCHEDULE

### HIGHWAY EXTINGUISHED BY THIS ORDER

Highway in the Borough of Douglas

A length of Waverley Road from its junction with the lane at the rear of Drury Terrace southwards to its junction with the lane at the rear of the northern side of Murrays Road; which highway is more particularly shown edged by a thick black line on the order map.

(This note is not a part of the Order)

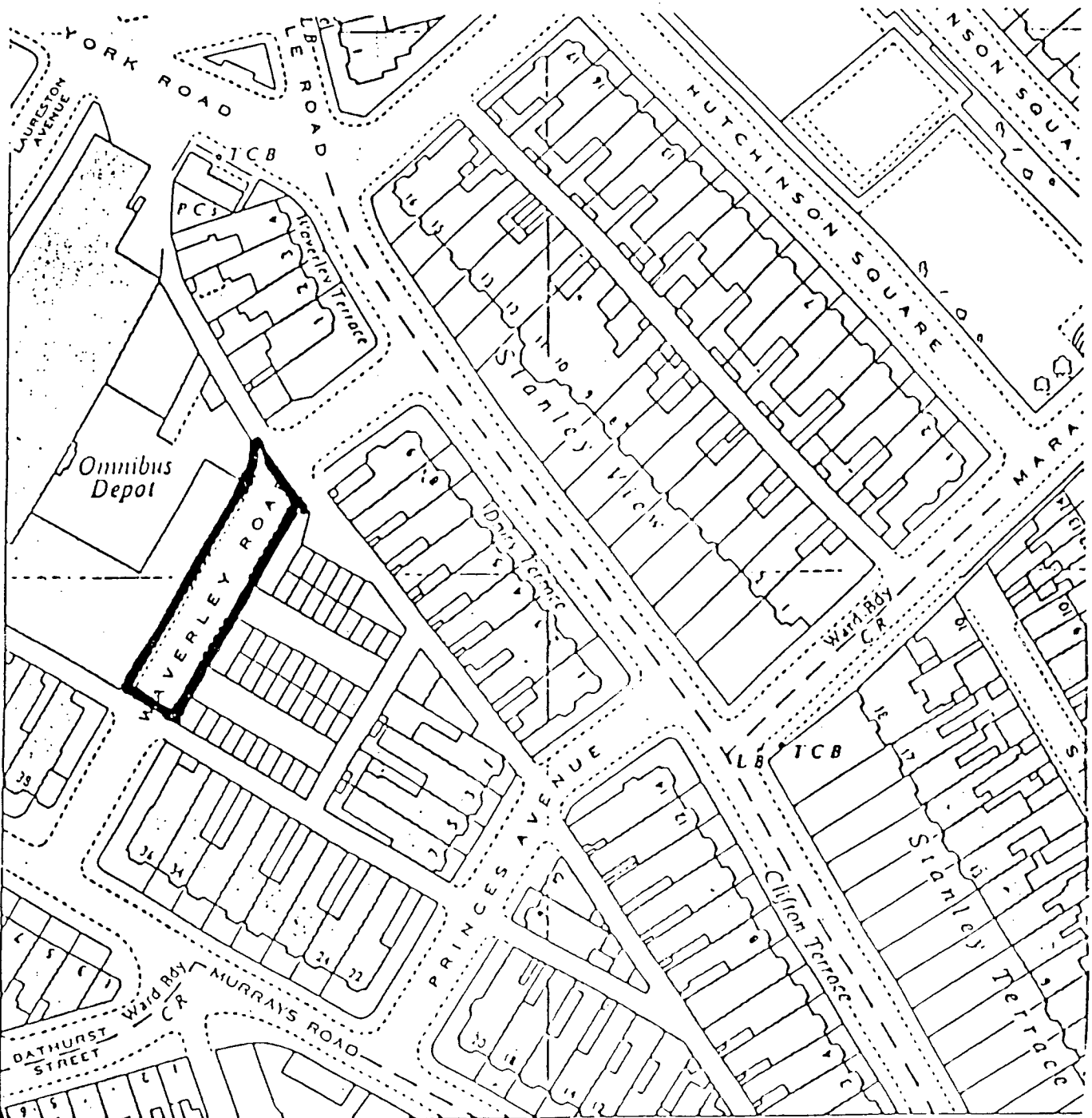
