GOVERNORS BRIDGE ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 38 of the Highways Act 1986 (a) and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Governor's Bridge Order 1990 and shall come into operation at 10.00 a.m. on Sunday 3rd June and will remain in force until 8.00 p.m. on that day.

Closure of Road To Traffic

2. No traffic shall proceed in that section of roadway, known as 'The Dip', Governors Bridge, in the Borough of Douglas.

Exemption

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to any person to proceed in that section of road when permitted by a police constable in uniform so to do.

Provision to Rescind

4. In the event of Sunday 3rd June 1990, being a day on which the aforesaid length of road is utilised for races with motor cycles as provided for under the provisions of Article 6 (2) of the Tourist Trophy Motor Cycle Races Order 1990, then Article 2 shall not have effect.

Notice of the Making of this Order

5. Public Notice of this Order shall be given by advertisement in two Isle of Man news papers.
