Road Races Act 1982

THE REGULATION OF TRAFFIC (T.T. RACES) ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 7 of the Road Races Act 1982 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Regulation of Traffic (T.T. Races) Order 1990, and shall come into operation on the 3rd June 1990.

Provision for One-Way Traffic

2. Subject to Article 3, on Sunday 3rd June 1990 from the hour of 10.00 a.m. until the hour of 8.00 p.m. vehicular traffic on the road leading from Ramsey to Douglas via Snaefell Mountain, commonly known as the Mountain Road, shall, between the Hairpin Corner and the Creg-ny-Baa corner, proceed in a southerly direction only.,

Provision to Rescind

3. In the event of Sunday, 3rd June 1990, being a day on which the aforesaid length of road is utilised for races with motorcycles as provided for under the provisions of Article 6 (2) of the Tourist Trophy Motor Cycle Race Order 1990, then Article 2 shall not have effect.

Notice of the Making of this Order

4. Public Notice of this Order shall be given by advertisement in two Isle of Man news papers.
