RAMSEY MARKET DAYS ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 38 of the Highways Act 1986 (a), section 1 of the Highway (Races and Entertainments) Act 1962 (b), and of all other enabling powers the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Ramsey Market Days Order 1990 and shall come into operation on the 19th May 1990.

Interpretation

2. In this Order -

"the Department" means the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties;

"the Committee" means the Ramsey Market Committee;

"market days" means each and every Saturday falling within the date 19th May, 1990 and 15th September, 1990 inclusive;

"market period" means from the hour of 7.00 a.m. until the market is officially notified as completed in accordance with Article 4, or until not later than the hour of 6.00 p.m., whichever may be the earlier;

"market site" means the area of roadway set out and described in the Schedule.

PART 1

Closure of Road and Temporary Suspension and Regulation of Traffic

3. On the market days during the market period the market site may be closed to, and the right of vehicular traffic to proceed thereover suspended for all vehicular traffic, other than such traffic as may be authorised by the Committee or by the Chief Constable.

PART 2

Erection of Barriers

4. During the market period the Committee shall cause barriers to be erected and maintained at or near the junction of the market site with those roads leading into the market site. Such barriers to be dismantled and removed immediately after the conclusion of the market period.

Erection of Stalls

5. During the market period the Committee may permit persons to erect stalls on the market site subject to compliance with the terms of any licence issued by the Ramsey Town Commissioners.

Duty of Committee to notify completion of Market

6. It shall be the duty of the Committee to make such provisions as seems most expedient for giving official notification to the public of the conclusion of the market and of the opening of the market site to traffic.

PART 3

Notice of Making of Order

7. Public notice of this Order shall be given in two Isle of Man newspapers.
