Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

JAMES STREET (DOUGLAS)
(PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the James Street (Douglas) (Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1990, and shall come into operation on the 2nd May 1990.

Vehicles Prohibition

2. Save as provided in Article 3 no person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed in the whole of James Street in the Borough of Douglas.

Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in the road referred to in that Article if the vehicle is being used:-
 - (a) for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to that length of road;
 - (b) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to that length of road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in that length of road, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of road, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that length of road of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus (within the meaning of the Telecommunications Act 1984) kept or to be kept installed for the purposes of a telecommunications code system (within the meaning of the Act); or

- (c) in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (d) in exercise of its functions as a fire brigade, ambulance or police vehicle.
