

NON-RESIDENT TRADERS ACT 1983

NON-RESIDENT TRADERS LICENCE (FEES) REGULATIONS 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Board of Consumer Affairs by sections 5 and 8 (1) (a) of the Non-Resident Traders Act 1983 (a) and all other powers enabling it in that behalf and after consultation with the Treasury and such organisations as it considers will represent interests which may be affected, the following Regulations are hereby made:-

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Non-Resident Traders Licence (Fees) Regulations 1990 and subject to section 8(3) of the Act, shall have effect in relation to the issue of a licence where the application is made after the 17th May 1990.

Interpretation

2. In these Regulations, "Act" means the Non-Resident Traders Act 1983.

Fees under section 5 of the Act.

3. The prescribed fee in respect of a licence issued under the Act shall be £1500 for the first three days for which the licence is valid, and £300 for each succeeding consecutive day.

Fees under General Circular No 191/87

4. In regulation 3 of the Non-Resident Traders Licence (Fees) Regulations 1987, for "£50" substitute "£150".

Revocation.

5. The Non-Resident Traders Licence (T.T. Races) (Exemption) Regulations 1984 are revoked.
