Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

ARBORY STREET (CASTLETOWN)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Arbory Street (Castletown) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1990 and shall come into operation at 8.00 a.m. on the 18th May, 1990.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that section of Arbory Street, Castletown situated between the properties thereon numbered 9 and 19.

Duration

3. This Order shall continue in force until the 24th May 1990, or until sewer connection work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

The effect of this Order is to close to vehicular traffic that length of Arbory Street, Castletown between the properties situated thereon numbered 9 and 19, during the period sewer connection work is being undertaken.
