



## WILDLIFE ACT 1990

### THE AYRES NATIONAL NATURE RESERVE DECLARATION 2000

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry by section 31 (1), and with the concurrence of the Treasury, as required by section 37 (3) of the Wildlife Act 1990 (a), the following declaration is hereby made:-

#### Citation

1. This Declaration may be cited as The Ayres National Nature Reserve Declaration 2000.

#### Interpretation

2. In this declaration -

"the Department" means Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry;

"the Reserve" means the land at the Ayres in the Parishes of Bride and Andreas and delineated by a thick black line on the attached plan.

#### Declaration

3. Whereas the Department is satisfied that the Reserve -
  - (a) is being managed as a nature reserve by the owner or occupier; and
  - (b) is a nature reserve of national importance for its flora, fauna, and geological and physiographical features,

the Reserve is declared to be a National Nature Reserve.
