



Sow Slaughter Premium (Amendment) Scheme 2000

Approved by Tynwald on 20th June 2000

Coming into operation on the 1st July 2000

Title and Commencement

1. This Scheme may be cited as the Sow Slaughter Premium (Amendment) Scheme 2000 and come into force on the 1st July 2000.

Amendments to the Sow Slaughter Premium Scheme 1999

2. (1) The Sow Slaughter Premium Scheme 1999 (a) shall be amended in accordance with the following paragraphs of this Scheme.

(2) In paragraph (2) for the words "the period 5th April 1999 to 2nd April 2000" substitute -

"the period 3rd April 2000 to 30th September 2000".

(3) For paragraph (4) substitute -

"4. The Department will pay a premium of £40 per sow on sows culled by a registered producer in the period 3rd April 2000 to 30th September 2000.

Application for premium payments shall be in such form and shall contain such particulars and be accompanied by such documents relating to the application as to enable the Department to determine the condition of eligibility have been satisfied."

Explanatory Note

(This is not part of the Scheme)

This Scheme amends the current Sow Slaughter Premium Scheme by extending its provisions beyond the 3rd April 2000 to the 30th September, 2000. It makes provision for all sows culled at the Meat Plant in the period to receive compensation of £40.
