## NOTES

### **1. Accuracy of Application**

The Road Traffic Commissioners are not responsible for the accuracy of applications. They are only responsible for seeing that the particulars of applications appearing in Part I of this publication are as supplied by the applicants. As the notice which appears in "Schedule of Applications and Decisions" is the only notice given of an application it is important that interested persons should scan each issue carefully.

The original application which gives details, can be inspected at the Office of the Road Traffic Commissioners.

### **2. Objections to Applications**

- (1) Every objection or representation in respect of an application for a licence shall be in writing and shall state the specific grounds on which it is based and shall specify any conditions which it may be desired should be attached to the licence, if granted. Every such objection or representation shall be sent to the Road Traffic Commissioners so as to reach them not later than FOURTEEN DAYS after notice of the application has appeared in "Schedule of Applications and Decisions". A copy of every such objection or representation shall be sent to the applicant at the same time as it is sent to the Road Traffic Commissioners.
- (2) Every objection or representation in respect of an application to vary the conditions attached to a road service licence shall state the specific grounds on which it is based and shall be sent to the Road Traffic Commissioners within FOURTEEN days from the date of the notice given by the Road Traffic Commissioners of the proposed application. A copy of such objection or representation shall be sent to the holder of the licence.
- (3) The objection or representation must be furnished SEPARATELY in respect of each application and should quote the reference number of the application concerned.

### **3. Applications to vary conditions**

The holder of a road service licence may at any time apply to the Road Traffic Commissioners to vary the conditions attached to his licence. Such application should be submitted in duplicate on Form PSV 89 and should provide the following information:-

- (1) the reference number of the licence concerned;
- (2) the condition or conditions to be varied;
- (3) details of the variation desired;
- (4) the reason for the application;
- (5) the names and addresses of any other operators or any Local Authority affected.

4. **Appeals from Decisions of the Road Traffic Commissioners**

Appeals from decisions of the Road Traffic Commissioners given with respect to road service licences may be made to the Department of Transport under statutory provision. This is contained in Section 15 of the Road Traffic (Public Service Vehicles) Act 1964.

A leaflet (PSV/C) giving more detailed information about appeal rights and procedures (including the time allowed for appeals) may be obtained on request from the Road Traffic Commissioners.

**VARIATION OF THE CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO ROAD SERVICE LICENCES**

- S/C 2/13
1. To run an additional Douglas to Peel Express journey at 1738 hours.
  2. To run the 1740 hours Douglas departure to Peel and Ramsey via Athol Street, and to run the 1738 hours journey at 1743 hours.
- S/C 2/Various
1. To implement multi-journey Explorer Tickets.
  2. To replace the current ten journey tickets with a new system of discount tickets offering twelve journeys with three price bands.
  3. To operate additional services on New Years morning, and to reduce services on Bank Holidays over the Christmas/New Year period.
- S/C 2/56
- To run the 1540 hours journey on the Ramsey Local Town Services, via Ramsey Grammar School, and to withdraw the 1810 hours service.

1. To delete the Ballaughton section on the 0835 hours journey between Douglas and the Strang.
  2. To run the current 0835 hours service at 0830 hours between Douglas and Strang.
