



THE BEEF QUALITY (HEADAGE PAYMENT) (AMENDMENT) SCHEME 2006

Approved by Tynwald 22nd February 2006

Coming into operation on 1st March 2006

1. Citation and Commencement

(1) This Scheme may be cited as the Beef Quality (Headage Payment) (Amendment) Scheme 2006.

(2) This Scheme shall come into operation on 1st March 2006.

2. Amendment of GC 47/99

In the Beef Quality (Headage Payment) Scheme 1999¹, for sub-paragraph 7(d) substitute –

“(d) carcasses of cattle which were older than 30 months of age at the time of slaughter;”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Scheme)

This Scheme amends sub-paragraph 7(d) of the Beef Quality (Headage Payment) Scheme 1999 to refer to the carcasses of cattle which were over 30 months of age at the time of slaughter. The carcasses of such animals were formerly excluded from the food chain by the Department of Local Government and the Environment's Beef (Emergency Control) Order 1996, which has now been revoked.
