Modifying the Direction Exempting Specified Non-residents from Regulation 5 of the Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (Entry Restrictions) (No. 2) Regulations 2020

WHEREAS the Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (Entry Restrictions) (No. 2) Regulations 2020 (“the Regulations”), in regulation 5, impose a prohibition from entering the Island that applies primarily to non-residents (as defined in regulation 3(1) of the Regulations);

AND WHEREAS regulation 10D of the Regulations authorises the Chief Secretary to make a direction exempting from the prohibition in regulation 5 individuals (whether or not they are residents of the Island) who travel to the Island from a specified location (specified in the direction) for the purposes of tourism;

AND WHEREAS the Chief Secretary made a direction on 14 August exempting individuals travelling from Guernsey, from the prohibition in regulation 5, subject to those individual meeting the criteria specified in that direction (thereby creating an airbridge between Guernsey and the Island) ;

AND WHEREAS the aforesaid regulation 10D of the Regulations enables the Chief Secretary to modify or discontinue an air bridge

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Will Greenhow, Chief Secretary, direct as follows:

1. The location specified for the purpose of this direction is the Bailiwick of Guernsey (hereafter “Guernsey”).
2. The operation of the airbridge permitted by the Direction Exempting Specified Non-residents from Regulation 5 of the Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (Entry Restrictions) (No. 2) Regulations 2020, made on 14 August 2020 [Government Circular No. 2020/0039], is hereby modified as follows:
 - 2.1 The operation of the airbridge is **suspended**.
3. This Direction takes effect immediately and will remain in effect until modified or discontinued pursuant to regulation 10D(4)(a) of the Regulations.
