Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

A5 DOUGLAS TO CASTLETOWN ROAD
(TEMPORARY VARIATION OF SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by Section 24 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1 This Order may be cited as the A5 Douglas to Castletown Road (Temporary Variation of Speed Limits) Order 1993 and shall come into operation on the 18th January 1993.


Temporary Variation of Speed Limit

2 The provisions of item 12(a) (ii) of the Rural Roads (Speed Limits) Order 1979 (b) shall be temporarily varied from 40mph to 30mph insofar as it relates to both carriageways of the A5 Douglas to Castletown Road from a point 357 metres south of its junction with Balthane Road to the Boundary of the town of Castletown.

Duration

3 This Order shall continue in force until 30th April 1993 or until the construction work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not a part of the Order

This Order effects the temporary variation of the speed limit from 40mph to 30mph on both carriageways of the A5 Douglas to Castletown Road from a point 357 metres south of its junction with Balthane Road in Ballasalla to the boundary of the town of Castletown for the period that construction work is being undertaken at Ronaldsway Airport.
