Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

FORT STREET (DOUGLAS)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1 This Order may be cited at the Fort Street (Douglas) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1993 and shall come into operation on the 25th January 1993.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2 No vehicular traffic shall proceed along Fort Street in the Borough of Douglas from its junction with Victoria Street in a south easterly direction for a distance of 27 metres.


Suspension of One-Way Traffic System

3 During the period this Order is in force, the one-way traffic system imposed on Fort Street by paragraph (13) (b) of the Borough of Douglas One-Way Streets Order 1981 (b) is suspended.

Duration

4 This Order shall continue in force until the 27th January 1993 or until the cable laying work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order

The effect of this Order is to close to vehicular traffic Fort Street, Douglas from its junction with Victoria Street in a south easterly direction for a distance of 27 metres during the period that cable laying work is being undertaken. The one-way traffic system over Fort Street from its junction with Victoria Street to its junction with Lord Street is suspended for the period the Order is in operation.
