BATTERY PIER AND BATTERY PIER WALKWAY (DOUGLAS)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1 This Order may be cited as the Battery Pier and Battery Pier Walkway (Douglas) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1993 and shall come into operation on the 26th January 1993.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2 Subject to Article 3, all vehicular and pedestrian traffic is prohibited from using that portion of the Battery Pier and Battery Pier Walkway in the Borough of Douglas edged with a thick black line on the map annexed to this Order and marked "Map referred to in the Battery Pier and Battery Pier Walkway (Douglas) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1993.

Exemptions

3 Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to:-

- (a) vehicular and pedestrian traffic engaged in works associated with the loading and discharging of ships; and
- (b) such traffic as may be authorised by the Chief Harbour Master.

Duration

4 This Order shall continue in force until the 26th July 1993.
