Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

SHORE ROAD (RUSHEN)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC)
ORDER 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1 This Order may be cited as the Shore Road (Rushen) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1993 and shall come into operation on the 27th January 1993.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2 No pedestrian or vehicular traffic shall proceed along that length of Shore Road, Rushen from its junction with the B45 Mt Gawne Road to its junction with the C24 Kentraugh Back Road.

Exemptions

3 Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the works to be carried out or those requiring access to property situated thereon.

Duration

4 This Order shall continue in force until the 27th April 1993 or until the road investigation work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to close to vehicular traffic, except for authorised traffic, and those requiring access to property, that length of Shore Road, Rushen from its junction with the B45 Mt Gawne Road to its junction with the C24 Kentraugh Back Road for the period that road investigation is being carried out.

An alternative route is via Ballabeg and Colby.
