Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

FINCH ROAD (DOUGLAS)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1 This Order may be cited as the Finch Road (Douglas) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1993 and shall come into operation on 6th February 1993.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2 No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that section of Finch Road in the Borough of Douglas from its junction with Crellins Hill to its junction with Christian Road.

Exemptions

3 Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the lifting work to be carried out.

Duration

4 This Order shall continue in force until 7th February 1993 and thereafter each weekend until the end of February 1993 ie 13th, 14th, 20th, 21st, 27th, 28th February 1993, or until the bridge erection work being undertaken is completed, whichever is the earlier.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in that section of Finch Road, Douglas from its junction with Crellins Hill to its junction with Christian Road each weekend throughout February 1993 or until the erection of the Museum Bridge is completed, whichever is the earlier.

An alternative route will be via Crellins Hill and Rosemount.
