FEEES AND DUTIES ACT 1989 (APPOINTED DAY) (NO. 3) ORDER 1993

Laid before Tynwald 16th February 1993

Coming into operation 1st April 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Treasury by section 9 of the Fees and Duties Act 1989(a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Fees and Duties Act 1989 (Appointed Day) (No. 3) Order 1993.

2. (1) The provisions of the Fees and Duties Act 1989 specified in the Schedule shall come into operation on 1 April 1993.



EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order)

This Order brings into force certain provisions of the Fees and Duties Act 1989 relating to the fees for Firearms certificates and the registration of firearms dealers.

The following provisions of the Act came into operation on 1st August 1990.
