THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

THE FUNCTIONS OF TRAFFIC WARDENS (AMENDMENT) ORDER 1993

Approved by Tynwald 16th February 1993

Coming into operation 1st April 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Home Affairs by section 33(3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985(a), and of all other enabling powers, the following order is hereby made:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Functions of Traffic Wardens (Amendment) Order 1993 and, subject to section 39(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985, shall come into operation on the 1st April 1993.

Amendment of 1989 Order

2. In the Schedule to the Functions of Traffic Wardens Order 1989(b), for paragraph 1(2) there is substituted —

"(2) For the purposes of the enforcement of the law with respect to such of the offences described in sub-paragraph (1) as are fixed penalty offences within the meaning of Schedule 5A to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985, traffic wardens may exercise the functions conferred on constables by the said Schedule 5A."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the Functions of Traffic Wardens Order 1989 consequentially on the introduction of a new fixed penalty procedure under Schedule 5A to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (added by the Road Traffic Act 1989). Traffic wardens continue to have the same powers as police constables to issue fixed penalty notices in respect of parking offences.
