Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

WATERLOO ROAD (RAMSEY)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1 This Order may be cited as the Waterloo Road (Ramsey) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1993 and shall come into operation on the 2nd February 1993.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2 No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed along that length of Waterloo Road from the Ramsey Youth Centre to its junction with Queens Drive.


Exemptions

3 Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicle engaged in the works to be carried out.

Duration

4 This Order shall continue in force until the 23rd May 1993 or until the sewerage work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note  
(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to close to vehicular traffic, except for authorised traffic, that length of Waterloo Road, Ramsey from the Ramsey Youth Centre to its junction with Queens Drive for the period that sewerage work is being carried out.

Alternative routes are via Queens Pier Road and Queens Drive or Queens Promenade, Market Place and West Quay.
