Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

SHORE ROAD (RUSHEN) (TEMPORARY WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1 This Order may be cited as the Shore Road (Rushen) (Temporary Weight Restriction) Order 1993 and shall come into operation on the 8th February 1993.

Temporary Weight Restriction

2 Save as provided in Article 3, no person shall cause any vehicle the weight of which, whether laden or unladen exceeds 3 tonnes to proceed in that length of the Shore Road in the Parish of Rushen from its junction with the Mount Gawne Road (B45) to a point adjacent to the Shore Hotel.

Exemptions

3 Nothing in Article 2 shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in that length of the road referred to in that Article if the vehicle is being used with the prior approval of the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties.

Duration

4 This Order shall continue in force until the 7th March 1993.

The effect of this Order is to impose a temporary weight restriction of 3 tonnes on a certain length of the Shore Road, Rushen for a 1 month period whilst monitoring works are being undertaken.
