Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

DOUGLAS STREET (A1) (PEEL)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and properties by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1 This Order may be cited as the Douglas Street (A1) (Peel) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1993 and shall come into operation on the 21st February 1993.


Closure of Road to Traffic

2 No person shall cause any vehicle other than authorised traffic to proceed in that length of Douglas Street, Peel from its junction with the Market Place to its junction with Michael Street.

Duration

3 This Order shall continue in force until the 24th February 1993 or until the remedial work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This Note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in the length of Douglas Street, Peel from its junction with the Market Place to its junction with Michael Street for the period that remedial works are being undertaken.

An alternative route will be via Patrick Street and Boilley Spittal.
