THE PENSIONERS' LUMP SUM PAYMENTS ORDER 1993

Approved by Tynwald 16 March 1993

Coming into operation 6th December 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Health and Social Security by paragraph 2(3)(b) of Schedule 6 to the Social Security Act 1986(a) (an Act of Parliament), as it has effect in the Isle of Man(b), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.(1) This Order may be cited as the Pensioners' Lump Sum Payments Order 1993, and, subject to section 83(4) of the Act, shall come into operation on 6th December 1993.
- (2) In this Order "the Act" means the Social Security Act 1986 (an Act of Parliament), as it has effect in the Isle of Man.

Amount of lump sum payment

2. The following sums are specified for the purposes of paragraph 2(3)(b) of Schedule 6 to the Act, namely -
 - (a) where one of the qualifying benefits referred to in paragraph 2(1)(b) is i) a supplementary pension or allowance, ii) family income supplement or iii) disability working allowance £50.00.
 - (b) in any other case, £35.00.

Revocation of G.C. 133/92

3. The Pensioners' Lump Sum Payments Order 1992(c) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

1. This Order provides for a lump sum payment (Christmas Bonus) to be made in respect of a person in whose case the provisions of paragraph 2 of Schedule 6 to the Social Security Act 1986 are satisfied for a day in the week beginning Monday 6th December 1993. The power in paragraph 2(3)(b) of Schedule 6 to the Act to provide for a larger lump sum payment than £10 has been exercised in this Order, such payments are to be where one of the qualifying benefits is i) a supplementary pension or allowance, ii) family income supplement or iii) disability working allowance £50.00; in other cases £35.00.
2. The estimated total cost of the payments, in the financial year ended 31 March 1993 is £783,000 of which £627,000 will be met from the National Insurance Fund, and £156,000 from General Revenue.
3. This Order revokes The Pensioners Lump Sum Payments Order 1992.
