PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO 296 (COLBY)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC) ORDER 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985(a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

- 1 This Order may be cited as the Public Footpath No 296 (Colby) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Traffic) Order 1993 and shall come into operation on the 10th March 1993.


Closure of Footpath

- 2 Pedestrian traffic except for access to fields situated thereon is prohibited from using Public Right of Way No 296 from its junction with Colby Bridge to its junction with Kentraugh Loop Road.

Duration

- 3 This Order shall continue in force until the 22nd March 1993 or until the sewer works are completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This Note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of the Order is to prohibit pedestrians except for access to fields from using Public Right of Way No 296 from its junction with Colby Bridge to its junction with Kentraugh Loop Road, during the period that sewer works are being undertaken.

An alternative route will be via Colby Level and Croit-e-Caley.
