Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

BOURNE PLACE (RAMSEY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Highways, Ports and Properties by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1 This Order may be cited as the Bourne Place (Ramsey) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1993 and shall come into operation at 8.00 a.m. on 7th March 1993.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2 No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that section of Bourne Place, Ramsey from its junction with Waterloo Road to its junction with Market Hill.


Exemptions

3 Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the road surfacing work to be carried out.

Duration

4 This Order shall continue in force until 6.00 p.m. on 7th March 1993 and thereafter each Sunday until the end of March 1993 ie 14th, 21st and 28th March 1993, or until the road surfacing work being undertaken is completed, whichever is the earlier.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in that section of Bourne Place, Ramsey from its junction with Waterloo Road to its junction with Market Hill each Sunday throughout March 1993 or until the road surfacing work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

An alternative route will be via Water Street and Court Row, the one-way system having been suspended for the duration of the Order.
